**TACTIC 2024 Conference** 






It was terrific to attend the TACTIC 2024 Conference in Port Augusta at the end of July.

RDAEP staff attended the Upper Spencer Gulf Workforce Summit held in Port Augusta on Tuesday 30th July.

The sessions focussed on the incredible opportunities emerging in the region and speakers included: SA Productivity Commissioner, Steve Whetton; Australian Government Employment and Workplace RElations State Manager, Tricia Hennessy; Minister for SA Housing, Nick Champion; SA Skills Commissioner, Cameron Baker along with many other local and State Government leaders.

Key conversations and presentations regarding the following themes were presented during the day:

- 1. Regional context and progress since 2023 Summit
- 2. National and State Initiatives
- 3. Enabling a Regional Workforce: Housing
- 4. Enabling a Regional Workforce: Skills and Training

## Working in Early Childhood Financial Support

SA residents can apply for financial assistance to offset costs related to approved early childhood study. There are 3 streams to the QualifySA in Early Childhood support program:

- Teacher support (up to \$25,000)
- Educator support (up to \$7,000)
- Aboriginal pathways (up to \$34,000)

Plus an additional allowance of up to \$10,000 is available to support students in regional and remote areas.
